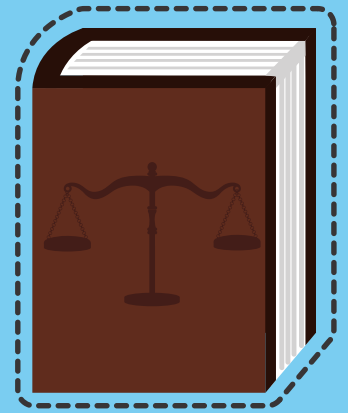


AUSTRALIA'S ESOS FRAMEWORK



ESOS ACT

- Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 - a law made by the Australian Parliament.
- Called the 'ESOS Act'.
- Regulates the provision of education to international students by Australian educational institutions.



NATIONAL CODE



- National Code of Practice for Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2018. Made under the ESOS Act.
- Provides nationally consistent standards for providing education to international students.
- Contains 11 standards that educational institutions must meet and maintain.

NATIONAL CODE STANDARD 4 - EDUCATION AGENTS

- Sets out how Australian educational institutions work with agents.
- One requirement is that institutions ensure their agents understand the international education system in Australia, including the Code of Ethics.



AGENT CODE OF ETHICS



- Provides standards specific to education agents working with Australian educational institutions.
- The standards build on the London Statement and mirror the requirements for education providers in the ESOS Act and National Code.
